PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63708 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Al Silbernagel of 16484 Old Mehama Road, Stayton, Oregon 97383, phone 769-2971, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring stream and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63707, Permit R-8469, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of a reservoir for stock use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 25, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 700 feet North and 840 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 8, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 9 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South Range 1 East, WM Section 8 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Stock use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
