## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63714 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to E.F. Steinborn of 19255 SW Pacific Highway, Sherwood, Oregon 97140, phone 625-7815, for the use of the waters of Chicken Creek, a tributary of Tualatin River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from June 28, 1982 for 1.01 cubic foot of water per second and June 30, 1982 for 0.66 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.67 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 2,300 feet North and 500 feet West from the Southwest Corner of Section 20, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 19 and Diversion 2 - 2,300 feet North and 2,300 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 20, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, both within Township 2 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, provided further that water shall not be diverted for irrigation during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
