PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62991 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clatsop County Economic Development Committee Fisheries Project of Oregon State University Seafoods Lab, 250 36th Street, Astoria, Oregon 97103, phone 325-4531, for the use of the waters of South Fork Klaskanine River, a tributary of Youngs River, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of salmon rearing pond constructed under Permit R-8108 for aquaculture; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 21, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 480 feet South and 408 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 31, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 7 North, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 7 North Range 8 West, WM Section 31 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Aquaculture

Use of water shall be restricted to the periods of June through July and October through December of each year.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
