PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63645 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Daniel A. Hanners of PO Box 475, Hood River, Oregon 97031, phone 386-3422, for the use of the waters of Spring I with any deficiency in the available supply from Spring I to be made up by appropriation from Spring 2, tributaries of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 18, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Diversion 1 (Spring 1)</u> - 410 feet North and 160 feet West; <u>Diversion 2 (Spring 2)</u> - 325 feet North and 20 feet West, both from the Southeast Corner of Nathaniel Coe DLC 37, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 North Range 10 East, WM Section 36 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.57 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
