## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63236 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Elon Marquand of PO Box 1833, Orleans, Massachusetts 02653, phone (617)523-1635, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 2, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 199.2 feet North and 70.9 feet East from the Quarter Corner common to Sections 33 and 34, being within the SW I/4 NW I/4 of Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South Range 13 West, WM Section 34 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for three families

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
