PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63774 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kenneth R. Nelson of 11301 Flynn Lane, Garden Grove, California 92640, phone (714)539-1280, for the use of the waters of Savage Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 19, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 842 feet South and 306.24 feet West from the Center of Section 30, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 36 South Range 4 West, WM Section 30 NE 1/4 SW 1/4

Domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial gerden not exceeding one-half acre in area

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
