PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63107 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Twin Lakes Ranch Property Owners Association of Powell Butte, Oregon 97753, phone 548-8445, for the use of the waters of Dry River, a tributary of Crooked River, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of a lake for recreation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 9, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.36 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Diversion 1</u> - 1,560 feet North and 430 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 3, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3 and <u>Diversion 2</u> - 1,245 feet North and 300 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, both within Township 15 South, Range 14 East, WM, in the County of Crook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

Township 15 South Range 14 East, WM Section 3 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Maintenance of a Section 10 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Take for recreation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
