PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63246 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Roy W. and Wilfred R. Daggett of PO Box D, Enterprise, Oregon 97828, phone 426-4588, for the use of the waters of Wallowa River, Prairie Creek and an unnamed stream locally known as McCully Creek, being 0.43 cubic foot of water per second from Wallowa River, 0.22 cfs from Prairie Creek and 0.22 cfs from the unnamed stream, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 8, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.87 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Wallowa River - South 77 degrees, 20 minutes East, 624 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 5, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 45 East; Prairie Creek - North 63 degrees, 39 minutes West, 2,337 feet from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 26, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 2 South, Range 45 East; and Unnamed Stream - North 76 degrees, 00 minutes West, 1,462 feet from the Southeast Corner of Section 2, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 2 South, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Wallowa.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township I South Range 45 East, WM Section 28 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 4.8 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4 29.7 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
