PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61164 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jerry O. Anderson of General Delivery, Richland, Oregon 97870, for the use of the waters of a spring stream, a tributary of Eagle Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 6, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 50 feet South and 75 feet West from the Northeast Corner of SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 8 South, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 South Range 45 East, WM Section 20 NW 1/4 SE 1/4

Domestic use for two families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to October 1987

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1987
