PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62250 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Wayne and Karen Barrows of Little River Route, Glide, Oregon 97443, phone 496-0109, for the use of the waters of Applegate River and 2.0 acre-feet stored water only from Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, supplemental irrigation, and livestock water; being 0.02 cubic foot per second from Applegate River for irrigation, 0.005 cfs from Applegate River for livestock water, and 2.0 acre-feet stored water only from Applegate Lake Reservoir for supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 12, 1981 for 2.0 acre-feet and February 17, 1982 for 0.025 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 780 feet North and 250 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine. Applegate Dam is located in S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South Range 6 West, WM Section 6 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.5 acres irrigation, and livestock water

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0388 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
