PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63387 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Daniel F. Hering of 34005 SW Cook Street, Hillsboro, Oregon 97123, phone 648-6153, for the use of the waters of Tualatin River, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 10, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.84 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 690 feet South 22 degrees East from the Northwest Corner of NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township I South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
