### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63959 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gary R. Clark, Manager, Oregon Employees Federal Credit Union of 660 Capitol Street, NE, Salem, Oregon 97301, phone 588-0211, for the use of the waters of Mill Creek, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of space heating and cooling; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 20, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,030 feet North and 1,220 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 7 South	Range 3 West, WM	Section 23	SW 1/4	SW 1/4	A nonconsumptive use for space heating and cooling of an office building using a water source heat pump
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Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
