PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 57290 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to R.H.L. Kelly Trust, c/o Peter D. Kelly, of Route 3, Box 59-A, The Dalles, Oregon 97058, phone 296-9815, for the use of the waters of Fifteenmile Creek, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 13, 1978, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 80 feet North and 2,240 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 4, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, and Diversion 2 - 930 feet South and 840 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 4, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 4, both being within Township 1 North, Range 15 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 7, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
