PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61412 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Joseph B. Fichtner of 1247 Panther Gulch Road, Williams, Oregon 97544, phone 846-7665, for the use of the waters of a spring, Panther Gulch and two reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-61411, Permit R-8490, being 0.40 cubic foot of water per second from the spring and 0.05 cfs from Panther Gulch, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 12, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.45 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 450 feet South and 170 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 12, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 12; Diversion 1A - 650 feet South and 300 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 11; and Diversion 2 - 880 feet North and 820 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 11, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 11, all within Township 39 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs to be constructed under Permit R-8490, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
