PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62752 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ervin A. Royer of Box 7, Catching Creek Route, Myrtle Point, Oregon 97458, phone 572-3587, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Catching Creek, for the PURPOSE of stock water and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for stock water and 0.0125 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 14, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0175 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,140 feet North and 890 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 19, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 19, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South	Range 12 West, WM	Section 19	SW 1/4	SW 1/4	Stock water
			SE 1/4	SW 1/4	Stock water and 1.0 acre irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 7, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to Oct. 1985

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1987
