## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63008 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Thomas Adrian Chance of Star Route, Rhododendron, Oregon 97049, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 2, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 gallon of water per minute measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 480 feet North and 70 feet East from the Southwest Corner of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 2 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South Range 7 East, WM Section 33 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 7, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
