PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63254 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Douglas County Land Department of Douglas County Courthouse, Room 320, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 440-4300, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Reservoir 3 to be constructed under Application R-62914, Permit R-8492, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of a reservoir for fire protection and fire protection, being 0.01 cubic foot of water per second for each use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 11, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,680 feet North and 155 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 7, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
