PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63447 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John E. Schlegel of Route 1, Bo 160-G, Herrison Road, Banks, Oregon 97106, phone 324-4533, for the use of the waters of Bledsoe Creek and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63446, Permit R-8494, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 2, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.76 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 140 feet South and 150 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 2 North, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8494, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year for irrigation except from stored water, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 7, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
