## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61015 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Adolf C. Klein of Route 2, Box 107, Milton-Freewater, Oregon 97862, phone 938-6850, for the use of the waters of Pine Creek, a tributary of Walla Walla River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation. The use allowed herein may be made anytime between October 1 and March 31 that water can be put to beneficial use by irrigation, either for immediate crop growth or for forecast requirements to raise the soil moisture to field capacity in the soil profile to be utilized by plant growth in the subsequent growing season; that the PRIORITY OF THE RICHT dates from November 24, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.74 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,200 feet South and 640 feet West from the Center of Section 35, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 6 North, Range 34 East, WM, in the County of Urnatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/60 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre for each acre irrigated during the period from October 1 to March 31, provided further that the right allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated in any one year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
