PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63332 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jon Melvin Richardson (Dirty Dozen) of 404 Chinook, Astoria, Oregon 97103, phone 325-7077, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Nehalem River, for the PURPOSE of campsite use for two trailers; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 1, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 757 feet East from the Quarter Corner common to Sections 23 and 24, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 5 North, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 North Range 7 West, WM Section 23 Portion of Gov't Lot 1 Campsite Section 24 Gov't Lot 5

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
