### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63457 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William E. and Delores Andyke for United States, Deschutes National Forest (Sisters Ranger District) of 3028 SE 55th, Portland, Oregon 97206, phone 775-5781, for the use of the waters of Metolious River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 8, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,275 feet South and 490 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South Range 9 East, WM Section 10 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
