## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63479 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to R.L. Hunsaker of PO Box 528, Fort Klamath, Oregon 97626, phone 381-2312, for the use of the waters of Anna Creek, a tributary of Wood River, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation from July 21 until the close of the irrigation season of each year; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 19, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.09 cubic feet per second measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Weekly Ditch) - 1,750 feet South and 150 feet West from the Northwest Corner of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 9; Diversion 2 (Loosley-Streeter-Cardwell Ditch) - 50 feet North and 2,900 feet West from the Northwest Corner of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 4, both being within Township 33 South, Range 7 1/2 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/160 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
