PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63906 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William S. and Elizabeth W. Fort of 815 Willacade Court, Springfield, Oregon 97477, phone 757-4495, for the use of the waters of Alder Creek, a tributary of Odell Lake, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 20, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,150 feet South and 2,100 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 15, being within the NE I/4 NW I/4 of Section 15, Township 23 South, Range 6 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 23 South Range 6 East, WM Section 15 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
