## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61018 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kevin and Kayle Smith of 144 South "F" Street, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-3654, for the use of the waters of an unnamed drainageway and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63596, Permit R-8501, a tributary of Goose Lake, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 25, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 100 feet North and 100 feet East from the 5 1/4 Corner of Section 29, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 39 South, Range 19 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South Range 19 East, WM Section 29 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 38.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-8501, and is subject to the terms and conditions of the stipulation between Lakeview Water Users, Inc. and Kevin W. Smith and Kayle W. Smith recorded at page 885, Volume 6, Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
