PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62606 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gerald and Marie Upshaw of 4430 West Amazon, Eugene, Oregon 97405, phone 686-8889 or 686-8892, for the use of the waters of an unnamed creek, a tributary of Lake Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation; being 0.005 cubic foot per second of water for domestic use for one family and 0.03 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 10, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.035 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,000 feet North and 200 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South Range 9 West, WM Section 14 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.5 acres and domestic use for one family

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
