

PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

DESCHUTES COUNTY

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63424 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Douglas L. and Rebecca L. Treadwell of B.B. Skyliners Road, Bend, Oregon 97701, phone 388-0732, for the use of the waters of Tumalo Creek, a tributary of Deschutes River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 24, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 768 feet South and 242 feet West from the Northeast Corner of NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 18 South, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 18 South Range 10 East, WM Section 10 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
