PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63806 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Phillip Drehmer of PO Box 27893, Los Angeles, California 90027, phone (213)663-0820, for the use of the waters of Tennile Lake, a tributary of Tennile Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden for each family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 30, 1982 for 0.01 cubic foot per second of water and September 20, 1982 for 0.01 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 900 feet North and 270 feet West from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 18, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 23 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. *Extended to Oct. 1985*

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
