PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63853 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Joseph C. and Ruth E. Wauters of 20898 Foss Road, Nehalem, Oregon 97131, phone 368-6658, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Peterson Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 19, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: North 39 degrees 02.5 minutes West 578.91 feet from the N1/4 Corner of Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 5 West, WM, being within the SE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 32, Township 3 North, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Tillamook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North Range 9 West, WM Section 5 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
