PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63508 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions

This permit is issued to John R. and Lois M. Davis for the United States, Deschutes National Forest of 2940 NW Aspen Street, Corvallis, Oregon 97330, phone 753-2906, for the use of the waters of Metolius River, a tributary of Deschutes River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family: that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 4, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.3 gallon per minute measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,820 feet South and 1,100 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 15, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South Range 9 East, WM Section 15 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 3, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
