PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63942 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Case Loos of Route 3, Box 293, Johnson Landing Road, Scappoose, Oregon 97056, phone 543-2440, for the use of the waters of drainage water via Santosh Ditch and 6.2 acre-feet stored water from a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63941, Permit R-8505, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; being 0.88 cubic foot per second of water from drainage water for irrigation and 6.2 acre-feet from the reservoir for supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 24, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.88 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 3,600 feet South and 2,000 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8; Diversion 2 - 2,400 feet South and 300 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 8, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, both being within Township 3 North, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Columbia.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8505, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 3, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
