PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63949 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Richard D. Howard, Jr. of Star Route 2, Box 576E, Chiloquin, Oregon 97624, phone 533-2539, for the use of the waters of Sprague River, a tributary of Williamson River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 25, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 375 feet South and 1,015 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South Range 9 East, WM Section 11 S 1/2 N 1/2 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 5.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 3, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
