PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63950 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John and Diane Weiershauser of Route I-E, Box 31, Scottsburg, Oregon 97473, phone 587-4259, for the use of the waters of Golden Creek, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 25, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,580 feet North and 680 feet East from the Corner common to Sections 8, 9, 17, and 16, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 22 South Range 9 West, WM Section 9, NW 1/4 SW 1/4

Demestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 3, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
