PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63972 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dan C. and Nelda M. Petroff of 1123 East 8th Street, The Dalles, Oregon 97058, phone 298-1010, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Deschutes River, for the PURPOSE of livestock watering; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 30, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 gallons per minute measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 340 feet South and 370 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 3, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 15 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North Range 15 East, WM Section 3 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Livestock watering

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 3, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
