## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64051 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Donald W. Neal of 1410 SW Morrison #804, Portland, Oregon 97205, phone 246-1972, for the use of the waters of Tualatin River and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-64055, Permit R-8507, tributaries of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and maintenance of a reservoir for wildlife attraction; being 0.04 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 0.08 cfs for reservoir maintenance; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 31, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.12 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Diversion 1 (Tualetin River)</u> - 100 feet North and 900 feet West; <u>Diversion 2 (Reservoir)</u> - 500 feet North and 1,200 feet West, both from the Southerly Southeast Corner of DLC 46, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South Range 2 West, WM Section 14 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Wildlife attraction and 3.25 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year. The right allowed herein for storage for wildlife attraction shall be subsequent and inferior to all future rights for beneficial consumptive use, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 3, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
