PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 53274 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jess Roberts of Route 6, Box 474, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, for the use of the waters of Willow Creek Reservoir constructed under Permit R-2332, and Application R-54866, Permit R-8508, a tributary of Drews Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 20, 1975, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 37.5 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,320 feet South from the Northeast Corner of Section 5, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 40 South, Range 18 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

Township 40 South Range 18 East, WM Section 4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 12.8 ecres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the Irrigation sesson of each year from storage of water from reservoir constructed under Permit R-8508, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
