PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63427 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions

This permit is issued to Douglass and Sandra Schmor of 1830 Concord Way, Medford, Oregon 97501, for the use of the waters of North Fork Rogue River, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 26, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 185 feet South and 665 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 3, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 31 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one Township 31 South Range 3 East, WM Section 3 family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October I, 1985.
