PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63467 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Michael Leuthold of South Coos River Route, Box 327, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 267-4739, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Morgan Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 15, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 535 feet South and 840 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 12, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South Range 12 West, WM Section 12 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for three families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
