## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63520 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Raymond Manning O'Connor of 5651 Zena Road, NW, Salem, Oregon 97304, phone 371-8242, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of an unnamed stream, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, stock, commercial spraying, and domestic use for four families being 0.02 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation, 0.005 cfs for stock, 0.13 cfs for commercial spraying, and 0.01 cfs for domestic use for four families; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 10, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.165 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 250 feet North and 850 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 23, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to October 1987

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1987
