### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63770 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Stiles Enterprises, Inc. and Elbert W. and Wyoming Stiles of PO Box 217, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-3478, for the use of the waters of an unnamed watercourse now enclosed in a 24-inch concrete pipe, a tributary of Klamath River, for the PURPOSE of heating, truck washing, and greenhouse uses; being 600.0 gallons per minute for heating, 25.0 gpm for truck washing, and 500.0 gpm for greenhouse uses; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 15, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 600.0 gpm measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: North 44 degrees 30 minutes West 1,100 feet from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 33, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 38 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 9 East, WM Section 33 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Heating, truck washing and greenhouse use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
