PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63842 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David E. Harris of 1024 Lincoln Avenue, San Diego, California 92103, phone (714)298-5884, for the use of the waters of Applegate River, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial gardens; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 12, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 560 feet South and 1,145 feet West from the Center of Section 15, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South Range 6 West, WM Section 15 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986
