PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 57011 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to L.D. Dalrymple, City Manager, City of Boardman of PO Box 228, Boardman, Oregon 97818, phone 481-9252, for the use of the waters of City of Boardman Sewage Lagoon to be constructed under Application R-57010, Permit R-8517, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 23, 1978, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 115.0 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 860 feet South and 1,150 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 11, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 4 North, Range 25 East, WM, in the County of Morrow.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 North Range 25 East, WM Section II NW 1/4 NE 1/4 15.0 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 25.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year of stored water only from reservoirs to be constructed under Permit R-8517.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1987
