PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 58323 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jere J. and Karen L. Christner of 4786 Brookwood, Eugene, Oregon 97405, phone 344-5180, for the use of the waters of Brush Creek, a tributary of Calapooya River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 14, 1979, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 320 feet North and 900 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Richard Findlay DLC 37, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 14 South, Range I West, WM, in the County of Linn.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 14 South Range 1 West, WM Section 18 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
