## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62412 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to C. Loren Bowman of 18340 Highway 238, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 846-6452, for the use of the waters of an unnamed guich and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-61828, Permit R-8519, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of a reservoir for recreational fishing and livestock use, being 0.03 cubic foot of water per second for recreational fishing and 0.0012 cfs for livestock use; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from June 23, 1981 for use of 0.03 cfs and June 20, 1982 for use of 0.0012 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0312 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,764 feet North and 1,540 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the SW I/4 NE I/4 of Section 21, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 4 West, WM Section 21 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Maintenance of a reservoir for recreational fishing and livestock use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
