## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63231 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dan Opie of PO Box 33, Lawen, Oregon 97740, phone 493-2547, for the use of the waters of Chapman Slough and an unnamed slough, being 1.26 cubic feet of water per second from Chapman Slough and 1.18 cfs from an unnamed slough, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 28, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.44 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1,100 feet South and 0.0 foot East from the Northwest Corner of Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15 and Diversion 2 - 35 feet North and 70 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 15, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, all within Township 24 South, Range 31 East, WM, in the County of Harney.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
