PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63965 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert L. Thrush of PO Box 773, Jacksonville, OR 97530, phone 899-1651, for the use of the waters of Wildcat Creek and 8.0 acre-feet stored water only from Thrush Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63964, Permit R-8520, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 30, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Wildcat Creek) - 330 feet North and 140 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 12 and Diversion 2 (Thrush Reservoir) - 1,120 feet North and 100 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 12, all being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 29 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South Range 9 West, WM Section 12 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 9.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8520, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 1 to September 30 of each year, except for stored water, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1987
