PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63970 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kyle W. and Eva A. Hankins of 4717 Summers Lane, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 884-6185, for the use of the waters of Alder Creek, a tributary of Jordan Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area for each and irrigation, being 0.01 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.056 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 30, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.066 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,630 feet South and 1,150 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 33, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
