PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64065 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Arthur Warren Swartzendruber of 590 SE Standish, Corvallis, Oregon 97333, phone 753-4351, for the use of the waters of Boonesville Slough, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 3, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 620 feet South and 480 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the SE I/4 SW I/4 of Section 23, being within the SE I/4 SW I/4 of Section 23, Township I2 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 12 South Range 5 West, WM Section 23 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 5.5 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4 3.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
