## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64136 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Cecil O. and Julia A. Vancil of PO Box 373, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, for the use of the waters of Canyon Creek, a tributary of John Day River, for the PURPOSE of mining use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 9, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 50 feet South and 200 feet East from the Southeast Corner of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 14 South, Range 31 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 14 South Range 31 East, WM Section 14 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Mining Use NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Mining Use

This permit is issued subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
