PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64137 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Stanley Richard Roberts of 443 Hawthorne Street, Monterey, California 93940, phone (408)373-6339, for the use of the waters of Daniel Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 9, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 700 feet North and 2,360 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 30 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South Range 2 West, WM Section 23 NE 1/4 SW 1/4	Domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area
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Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
