PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64171 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Marion and India Sargent of Route 1, Box 541, John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 932-4851, for the use of the waters of Laycock Creek, a tributary of John Day River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 23, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1,420 feet South and 200 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 36, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 36 and Diversion 2 - 370 feet South and 270 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 36, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 36, both being within Township 13 South, Range 30 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
